The Board of Directors are representatives who are elected by membership of the community association. It is the Board's responsibility to maintain the common areas of the association, approve budgets, act with the utmost good faith and reasonable care for the benefit of the association and its members, and make decisions which strive for the betterment of the association and the community.

ICON's Annual Meeting will occur on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>April 11</u>, <u>2024</u>. The purpose of the Annual Meeting is to elect three (3) positions to the Board of Directors. The term of a director is two years.

ICON's governing documents state the following candidate qualifications must be met in order to serve as a member of the Board of Directors. Per Civil Code §5105(e), any potential candidate shall not be disqualified from nomination if the potential candidate has not been provided the opportunity to engage in internal dispute resolution.

- Candidates must be Members of the Association. Any Member that is not a natural person (such as a corporate Member or trust) may appoint a natural person to be a candidate on its behalf.
- Only one Owner per separate interest (unit) shall be eligible to serve on the Board at any time.
- Candidates must not be delinquent in the payment of any regular or special assessments, with the exception of Owners who have entered into a valid payment plan with the Association.
- Candidates must have held membership in the Association for at least one (1) year prior to the date of the election.
- Candidates must not have been convicted of a crime that would prevent the Association from obtaining or maintaining fidelity bond coverage required by Civil Code §5806.
- Candidates must agree to sign and be bound by the Board Code of Ethics and Standards of Conduct, if elected.
